Leaders for Geelong Program

- The 2022 Leaders for Geelong program is a one year program that builds community leadership capability. The program is in its 16th year and features incredible networking opportunities, behavioural assessments, workshops and seminars, and a community-based action project.
- The Leaders for Geelong program welcomes a diversity of applicants from all ages and backgrounds.
- The program incorporates best practice adult learning principles and approaches, including 10% Formal Learning, 20% Social Learning and 70% applied and informal learning. Structured training delivers a set of knowledge and skills via inpractice learning for emerging community leaders.
- Practical application through experiential work is required on the co-designed community projects that are aligned to the Barwon Regional Leadership priorities.
- Participants will have access to a range of the region's most well-renowned and respected leaders and thinkers and through this exposure, consider issues relevant to the region and what kind of leader they want to be.
- Most importantly, graduates take action beyond the programs and become part of an enduring Alumni network of 450 graduates.
